Program Descriptions

PreCanSkate (KidSkate)

PreCanSkate is a learn-to-skate program geared towards beginner skaters aged 3 to 5. The program is designed to give skaters the basics of skating in a fun, play-based environment while implementing our 8 fundamental skills. This program is perfect for skaters with little or no skating experience.
